Latino Diversity in Massachusetts School System:

Improving public policy is not enough to reduce historical discrimination and barriers to integration. A complete set of strategies must be in place to promote diversity, understanding and integration. Early childhood strategies and a system of integrative activities among parents, students, authorities and teachers can produce better spaces for a better school environment to Latino legal immigrants.

Home-School Connection Program (With TUFTS University):

The Home-School Connection Program (H-SCP) promotes the school success of immigrant children and further our understanding of the school adaptation process.

Promoting Integration (Environmental Justice):
